

Athlete Disclosure Policy

(Approved by CWASC Board of Directors on October 12, 2020)

Calgary Westside Alpine Ski Club (CWASC) relies on proactive disclosure from families to relay to the Program Director any medical, physical, emotional, cognitive or behavioural issues of an athlete which may impact our coaching staff and the other athletes or members of the Club.

Such disclosure is required prior to the ski season, preferably at the time of registration, so that adjustments to the coaching staff and grouping of athletes can be made.

Parents/guardians/athletes must also report any new concerns/issues in a timely fashion, when such issues may limit or affect and athlete or the Team's ability to train or compete.

Problems arising from medical, physical, emotional, cognitive, or behavioural issues will be dealt with by coaches using the Athlete Code of Conduct as their guide.
